TLILIC0003 - Licence to operate a Forklift Truck

What Will I Receive Upon Completion?

A Statement of Attainment will be issued by CTI and a High Risk Work Licence will be issued by WorkSafe Victoria, after lodging your Competent Notice of Assessment Online at a cost of \$66.60.

What Content is covered in the Training?

This course describes the skills and knowledge required to operate a forklift truck including: planning the work, conducting routine checks on the forklift, shifting loads in a safe manner, and shutting down and securing the equipment after the completion of operations.

Units

Participants need to complete one unit consisting of: Licence to operate a forklift truck

Who Can Undertake the Training?

Students are required to be over 18 years old, competent in written and spoken English and will undertake a Language, Literacy, and Numeracy test prior to commencing the training.

Course Pre-requisites

You will need to obtain a USI (Unique Student Identification) number. If you are under the age of 25 years old, your VSN (Victorian Student Number) will also be required.

A Student Enrolment Form and a Pre Training Review Form will need to be completed prior to attending.

PPE and appropriate clothing is required to be worn.

Course Pre-learning requirements

On enrolment, you will be sent some Pre learning in the form of a workbook that will need to be completed prior to attending.

How is the Course Trained and Assessed?

The course is delivered with both theory and practical elements and is completed via a simulated work environment. The delivery of training will include a mixture of classroom delivery, group discussions and individual research. Assessment is used to provide you with feedback on your progress and to measure your skills and knowledge against the training qualification requirements and those of the industry. The assessment process may include written questions, case studies and practical demonstrations.
